<p>Monday Dance Caravan 3-Kindergarten 2:45-3:15pm-Boys 3:15-3:45pm-Girls \$185/eleven weeks</p>	<p>Kids' Dance Caravan is a unique dance and performance program for both boys and girls. This class, unlike our other programs is 11 weeks long and concludes with a holiday show. The class will be a combination of modified tap and hip-hop for boys. The girl's class will consist of ballet, tap and jazz. The final show is a wonderful self-esteem booster and a great experience. All the costumes are provided at no charge! The goal of the instruction is to teach poise, coordination, grace and charm. Beverly, the director has been teaching dance for more than 35 years.</p>
<p>Monday – Bricks 4 Kids 4-Kindergarten 2:45-3:45pm \$160/eight weeks</p>	<p>Bricks 4 Kids is designed to promote S.T.E.M. learning, encourage collaboration and develop critical thinking skills. This is accomplished through structured model building classes using LEGO elements including gears, motors and battery packs. This is a hands-on class, where students build machines, vehicles, animals and other structures using BRICKS4Kidz's copyrighted model plans. The class will include a discussion on a STEM concept based on the model. The structure is built in teams of two and ends with the students unleashing their creativity to modify the model. The class is fun, exciting (always interesting modifications) and educational, a great combination.</p>
<p>Tuesday Baking 4-9 Years Old - 3:00-4:00PM \$155/eight weeks</p>	<p>Bake with Mrs. Fritsch! Children will learn about dry and wet ingredients, creaming butter and sugar together and many other baking techniques. Each child will measure and make their own baked goods.(muffins, cakes, cookies, etc.) EGGS and WHEAT products will be used in this class - New recipes</p>
<p>Tuesday - Tae Kwon Do 4-9 years old- 3:00-4:00pm \$200/eight weeks</p>	<p>Sky & Tri Tae Kwon Do benefits a child's level of confidence, perseverance, cooperation, responsibility and discipline. The class instructors, Grand Master Chun Park and Master Narae Kim will engage the students in an exercise routine that includes: stretching, running, kicking, blocks and punches. The exercises will develop flexibility, stamina, cardiac strength, muscle strength and balance.</p>

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Wednesday Art-4-All 4yrs. old - Kindergarten - 2:45-3:45 PM \$160/eight weeks	Art-4-All will continue their special Fine Arts program. The class will consist of creative fine art experiences with an emphasis on creativity and self-awareness through visual expression. The children will use tempera, watercolor, acrylics, marker, collage, chalk, paper sculpture, clay and glazes, and various printmaking techniques. All materials are included in the fee. Classes are limited to ensure that individual needs can be met.
Wednesday - Chess Elementary Students – 3:00-4:15pm \$170/eight weeks	King and Queens Chess Academy's goal is to introduce the beautiful game of chess to all the young and nourishing minds that have demonstrated an interest. Learning chess is not just going to make the students good chess players; it is also going to make them better thinkers! Analyzing the position, planning ahead, evaluating opponent plans and learning to focus are some of the key aspects of the game.
Thursday- Pre K Kickers 4yrs old - Kindergarten - 2:45-3:45 PM \$165/eight weeks	Pre K Kickers is a fun, fresh and inspiring organization that specializes in soccer training. This program will provide a positive and fun experience with soccer. The Pre K Kickers' method of instruction will teach the children to have fun while learning. The goal is to have every child finish the program with enhanced social and physical skills and to prepare the children for the next level of the game. The earlier children are exposed to sports and physical activities, the stronger they will become.
Friday-NJ Academy of Music 3-Kindergarten 2:45-3:30PM \$200/eight weeks	The NJ Academy of Music's Pre-Studio music preparatory class is a fun, energetic class with an emphasis on listening, introduction to rhythm, learning about types of instruments, trying instruments (including violin, viola, guitar, cello, piano, and drums), following sequences of directions and more. Geared for students in Pre-K and Kindergarten, this class allows students to experience the world of music and can serve as a stepping stone toward private music lessons.

Your club registration will not be processed until payment is received. Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Once a club is filled, registration will no longer be accepted in the system. Your child must be 3 years of age by January 4, 2018 to be eligible to participate. Registration will close on Friday, December 8, 2017.

Enrollment is limited for each club. In the event that not enough students register for a club, the club will be canceled. You will be notified the week of December 18, 2017 regarding acceptance into the individual clubs. Clubs will begin on Thursday, January 4, 2018.
